NORFOLK, Va. (May, 2007) – Norfolk International Airport (NIA) reported a 1.98 percent increase in passenger activity for the month of April 2007 with 310,957 passengers. This figure compares to an April 2006 passenger count of 304,913.

For the first four months, January through April 2007, passenger counts have increased .18 percent with a total passenger count of 1,108,172.

In other activity, 5,431,811 pounds of cargo were shipped in and out of the airport during April 2007. This represents a .44 percent increase from April 2006, which saw 5,407,821 pounds of cargo shipped. For the first four months of 2007, cargo shipments have increased 5.05 percent over the same period of time in 2006.

The above-mentioned figures are a reflection of the service by the following airlines: American, American Eagle, Continental, Continental Express, Delta, Delta Connection, Northwest, Northwest AirlinK, Southwest, United Express, US Airways and US Airways Express. Cargo carriers include Airborne, Federal Express and UPS.
