Norfolk International Airport reports on April 2008 activity

NORFOLK, Va. (May 30, 2008) – Norfolk International Airport (NIA) reported a 6.59 percent decrease in passenger activity for the month of April 2008 with 290,474 passengers. This figure compares to an April 2007 passenger count of 310,957.

The passenger count during the four month period - January through April 2008, was 1,078,442, a 2.68% decrease over the same time period the previous year which saw a total passenger count of 1,108,172.

In other activity, 5,462,297 pounds of cargo were shipped in and out of the airport during April 2008. This represents a .56 percent increase from April 2007, which saw 5,431,811 pounds of cargo shipped. During the first four months of 2008, 21,555,599 pounds of cargo were shipped, a 4.60% decrease over the same time period in 2007.

The above-mentioned figures are a reflection of the service by the following airlines: American, American Eagle, Continental, Continental Express, Delta, Delta Connection, Northwest, Northwest AirlinK, Southwest, United Express, US Airways and US Airways Express. Cargo carriers include Airborne, Federal Express and UPS.
