Norfolk International Airport reports on February 2009 activity

NORFOLK, Va. (March 16, 2009) – Norfolk International Airport (NIA) reported a 12.08 percent decrease in passenger activity for the month of February 2009 with 212,053 passengers. This figure compares to a February 2008 passenger count of 241,191.

The passenger count during the 2-month period - January through February 2009, was 448,782, an 8.78 percent decrease over the same time period the previous year, which saw a total passenger count of 491,987.

In other activity, 4,373,107 pounds of cargo were shipped in and out of the airport during February 2009. This represents a 17.25 percent decrease from February 2008, which saw 5,284,748 pounds of cargo shipped.

The above-mentioned figures are a reflection of the service by the following airlines: American, American Eagle, Continental, Continental Express, Delta, Delta Connection, Northwest, Northwest Airlink, Southwest, United Express, US Airways and US Airways Express. Cargo carriers include Federal Express and UPS.

Norfolk International Airport (NIA) is the major airport serving southeastern Virginia with 85 daily departures provided by American, American Eagle, Continental, Continental Express, Delta, Delta Connection, Northwest, Northwest Airlink, Southwest, United Express, US Airways and US Airways Express. NIA is ranked as the 65th largest airport in the United States with over 3.5 million passengers served in 2008.
