NORFOLK, Va. (June 25, 2007) – Norfolk International Airport (NIA) reported a .96 percent increase in passenger activity for the month of May 2007 with 345,757 passengers. This figure compares to a May 2006 passenger count of 342,464.

For the first five months, January through May 2007, passenger counts have increased .36 percent with a total passenger count of 1,453,929.

In other activity, 6,239,118 pounds of cargo were shipped in and out of the airport during May 2007. This represents a 10.93 percent increase from May 2006, which saw 5,624,412 pounds of cargo shipped. For the first five months of 2007, cargo shipments have increased 6.27 percent over the same period of time in 2006.

The above-mentioned figures are a reflection of the service by the following airlines: American, American Eagle, Continental, Continental Express, Delta, Delta Connection, Northwest, Northwest AirlinK, Southwest, United Express, US Airways and US Airways Express. Cargo carriers include Airborne, Federal Express and UPS.
