**Norfolk International Airport reports on November 2007 activity**

**NORFOLK, Va. (December 19, 2007)** – Norfolk International Airport (NIA) reported a 1.49 percent decrease in passenger activity for the month of November 2007 with 292,584 passengers. This figure compares to a November 2006 passenger count of 297,024.

For the first eleven months, January through November 2007, passenger counts have increased .85 percent with a total passenger count of 3,431,345.

In other activity, 5,750,583 pounds of cargo were shipped in and out of the airport during November 2007. This represents a 5.26 percent decrease from November 2006, which saw 6,070,159 pounds of cargo shipped. For the first eleven months of 2007, cargo shipments have increased 2.76 percent over the same period of time in 2006.

The above-mentioned figures are a reflection of the service by the following airlines: American, American Eagle, Continental, Continental Express, Delta, Delta Connection, Northwest, Northwest AirlinK, Southwest, United Express, US Airways and US Airways Express. Cargo carriers include Airborne, Federal Express and UPS.
