Norfolk Airport Authority Closes Moving Walkway on Pedestrian Bridge at Norfolk International Airport

NORFOLK, Va. – (Oct 6, 2017) – Norfolk Airport Authority has closed the moving walkway on the pedestrian bridge at Norfolk International Airport. The pedestrian bridge is a one-of-a-kind custom built walkway that has been in continuous operation for 15 years. After a thorough evaluation by consultants, it has been determined that the walkway has reached its end of life and will be removed.

The Authority will continue to study viable alternatives for a possible replacement at some point in the future. Meanwhile, the walkway will be removed and the carpet on the Pedestrian Bridge will be replaced with flooring that better accommodates wheeled devices. We are in the design phase of this part of the project.
