Norfolk International Airport reports on April 2013 activity

NORFOLK, Va. – (May 20, 2013) – Norfolk International Airport (ORF) reported a 7.36 percent decrease in passenger activity for the month of April 2013 with 253,401 passengers. This figure compares to a April 2012 passenger count of 273,530. For the January - April 2013 period, passenger activity has decreased 4.60 percent versus the corresponding period in 2012

In other activity, 4,714 726 pounds of cargo were shipped in and out of the airport during April 2013. This represents an 18.39 percent decrease versus April 2012, which saw 5,777,297 pounds of cargo shipped. For the January - April 2013 period, cargo activity has decreased 4.92 percent versus the corresponding period in 2012

The above-mentioned figures are a reflection of the service by the following airlines: American, Delta, Southwest, United, US Airways and their regional airline partners. Cargo carriers include Federal Express, Mountain Air Cargo and UPS.

Norfolk International Airport (ORF) is the major airport serving Coastal Virginia and Northeast North Carolina with 81 daily departures provided by American, Delta, Southwest, United, US Airways and their regional airline partners. According to the FAA, ORF is ranked as the 68th largest primary airport in the United States (2011) with nearly 3.3 million scheduled passengers served in 2012.
