Norfolk International Airport reports on April 2014 activity

NORFOLK, Va. – (May 13, 2014) – Norfolk International Airport (ORF) reported a 1.2 percent increase in passenger activity for the month of April 2014 with 256,446 passengers. This figure compares to an April 2013 passenger count of 253,401. For the January - April 2014 period, passenger activity has decreased 0.31 percent versus the corresponding period in 2013.

In other activity, 4,808,623 pounds of cargo were shipped in and out of the airport during April 2014. This represents a 1.99 percent increase versus April 2013, which saw 4,714,726 pounds of cargo shipped. For the January - April 2014 period, cargo activity has decreased 13.65 percent versus the corresponding period in 2013.

The above-mentioned figures are a reflection of the service by the following airlines: AirTran, American, Delta, Southwest, United, US Airways and their regional airline partners. Cargo carriers include Federal Express, Mountain Air Cargo and UPS.

Norfolk International Airport (ORF) is the major airport serving Coastal Virginia and Northeast North Carolina with 68 daily departures provided by Air Tran, American, Delta, Southwest, United, US Airways and their regional airline partners. According to the FAA, ORF is ranked as the 67th largest primary airport in the United States (2012) with over 3.1 million scheduled passengers served in 2013.
