Norfolk International Airport reports on December 2014 activity

NORFOLK, Va. – (January 21, 2015) – Norfolk International Airport (ORF) reported a 12.82 percent decrease in passenger activity for the month of December 2014 with 236,711 passengers. This figure compares to a December 2013 passenger count of 271,534. For the January - December 2014 period, passenger activity has decreased 4.72 percent versus the corresponding period in 2013.

In other activity, 5,288,216 pounds of cargo were shipped in and out of the airport during December 2014. This represents a 5.63 percent increase versus December 2013, which saw 5,006,514 pounds of cargo shipped. For the January - December 2014 period, cargo activity has decreased 4.26 percent versus the corresponding period in 2013.

The above-mentioned figures are a reflection of the service by the following airlines: AirTran, American, Delta, Southwest, United, US Airways and their regional airline partners. Cargo carriers include Federal Express, Mountain Air Cargo and UPS.

Norfolk International Airport (ORF) is the major airport serving Southeast Virginia and Northeast North Carolina with 60 daily departures provided by American, Delta, Southwest, United, US Airways and their regional airline partners. According to the FAA, ORF is ranked as the 69th largest primary airport in the United States (2013) with nearly 3 million scheduled passengers served in 2014.
