**Norfolk International Airport reports on February 2014 activity**

**NORFOLK, Va. – (March 12, 2014)** – Norfolk International Airport (ORF) reported a 0.87 percent decrease in passenger activity for the month of February 2014 with 189,594 passengers. This figure compares to a February 2013 passenger count of 191,260.

In other activity, 4,270,018 pounds of cargo were shipped in and out of the airport during February 2014. This represents a 13.01 percent decrease versus February 2013, which saw 4,908,759 pounds of cargo shipped.

The above-mentioned figures are a reflection of the service by the following airlines: AirTran, American, Delta, Southwest, United, US Airways and their regional airline partners. Cargo carriers include Federal Express, Mountain Air Cargo and UPS.

*Norfolk International Airport (ORF) is the major airport serving Coastal Virginia and Northeast North Carolina with 67 daily departures provided by Air Tran, American, Delta, Southwest, United, US Airways and their regional airline partners. According to the FAA, ORF is ranked as the 67<sup>th</sup> largest primary airport in the United States (2012) with over 3.1 million scheduled passengers served in 2013.*
