Norfolk International Airport reports on January 2015 activity

NORFOLK, Va. – (February 17, 2015) – Norfolk International Airport (ORF) reported a 3.69 percent decrease in passenger activity for the month of January 2015 with 200,417 passengers. This figure compares to a January 2014 passenger count of 208,087.

In other activity, 4,765,011 pounds of cargo were shipped in and out of the airport during January 2015. This represents a 10.01 percent increase versus January 2014, which saw 4,331,350 pounds of cargo shipped.

The above-mentioned figures are a reflection of the service by the following airlines: American, Delta, Southwest, United, US Airways and their regional airline partners. Cargo carriers include Federal Express, Mountain Air Cargo and UPS.

Norfolk International Airport (ORF) is the major airport serving Southeast Virginia and Northeast North Carolina with 60 daily departures provided by American, Delta, Southwest, United, US Airways and their regional airline partners. According to the FAA, ORF is ranked as the 69th largest primary airport in the United States (2013) with nearly 3 million scheduled passengers served in 2014.
