**Norfolk International Airport reports on June 2013 activity**

**NORFOLK, Va. – (July 16, 2013)** – Norfolk International Airport (ORF) reported a 5.67 percent decrease in passenger activity for the month of June 2013 with 303,295 passengers. This figure compares to a June 2012 passenger count of 321,533. For the January - June 2013 period, passenger activity has decreased 4.89 percent versus the corresponding period in 2012.

In other activity, 4,483,936 pounds of cargo were shipped in and out of the airport during June 2013. This represents a 27.84 percent decrease versus June 2012, which saw 6,213,839 pounds of cargo shipped. For the January - June 2013 period, cargo activity has decreased 12.63 percent versus the corresponding period in 2012.

The above-mentioned figures are a reflection of the service by the following airlines: American, Delta, Southwest, United, US Airways and their regional airline partners. Cargo carriers include Federal Express, Mountain Air Cargo and UPS.

*Norfolk International Airport (ORF) is the major airport serving Coastal Virginia and Northeast North Carolina with 81 daily departures provided by American, Delta, Southwest, United, US Airways and their regional airline partners. According to the FAA, ORF is ranked as the 68<sup>th</sup> largest primary airport in the United States (2011) with nearly 3.3 million scheduled passengers served in 2012.*
