Norfolk International Airport reports on May 2013 activity

NORFOLK, Va. – (June 14, 2013) – Norfolk International Airport (ORF) reported a 4.93 percent decrease in passenger activity for the month of May 2013 with 281,701 passengers. This figure compares to a May 2012 passenger count of 296,303. For the January - May 2013 period, passenger activity has decreased 4.68 percent versus the corresponding period in 2012.

In other activity, 4,862,632 pounds of cargo were shipped in and out of the airport during May 2013. This represents an 23.94 percent decrease versus May 2012, which saw 6,393,150 pounds of cargo shipped. For the January - May 2013 period, cargo activity has decreased 9.26 percent versus the corresponding period in 2012.

The above-mentioned figures are a reflection of the service by the following airlines: American, Delta, Southwest, United, US Airways and their regional airline partners. Cargo carriers include Federal Express, Mountain Air Cargo and UPS.

Norfolk International Airport (ORF) is the major airport serving Coastal Virginia and Northeast North Carolina with 81 daily departures provided by American, Delta, Southwest, United, US Airways and their regional airline partners. According to the FAA, ORF is ranked as the 68th largest primary airport in the United States (2011) with nearly 3.3 million scheduled passengers served in 2012.
