Norfolk International Airport reports on May 2014 activity

NORFOLK, Va. – (June 13, 2014) – Norfolk International Airport (ORF) reported a 0.79 percent increase in passenger activity for the month of May 2014 with 283,917 passengers. This figure compares to a May 2013 passenger count of 281,701. For the January - May 2014 period, passenger activity has decreased 0.05 percent versus the corresponding period in 2013.

In other activity, 4,765,553 pounds of cargo were shipped in and out of the airport during May 2014. This represents a 2.00 percent decrease versus May 2013, which saw 4,862,632 pounds of cargo shipped. For the January - May 2014 period, cargo activity has decreased 11.42 percent versus the corresponding period in 2013.

The above-mentioned figures are a reflection of the service by the following airlines: AirTran, American, Delta, Southwest, United, US Airways and their regional airline partners. Cargo carriers include Federal Express, Mountain Air Cargo and UPS.

Norfolk International Airport (ORF) is the major airport serving Coastal Virginia and Northeast North Carolina with 68 daily departures provided by Air Tran, American, Delta, Southwest, United, US Airways and their regional airline partners. According to the FAA, ORF is ranked as the 67th largest primary airport in the United States (2012) with over 3.1 million scheduled passengers served in 2013.
