**Norfolk International Airport reports on November 2013 activity**

**NORFOLK, Va. – (December 18, 2013)** – Norfolk International Airport (ORF) reported a 10.98 percent decrease in passenger activity for the month of November 2013 with 241,512 passengers. This figure compares to a November 2012 passenger count of 271,309. For the January - November 2013 period, passenger activity has decreased 6.32 percent versus the corresponding period in 2012.

In other activity, 4,303,975 pounds of cargo were shipped in and out of the airport during November 2013. This represents a 24.39 percent decrease versus November 2012, which saw 5,692,158 pounds of cargo shipped. For the January - November 2013 period, cargo activity has decreased 17.35 percent versus the corresponding period in 2012.

The above-mentioned figures are a reflection of the service by the following airlines: AirTran, American, Delta, Southwest, United, US Airways and their regional airline partners. Cargo carriers include Federal Express, Mountain Air Cargo and UPS.

*Norfolk International Airport (ORF) is the major airport serving Coastal Virginia and Northeast North Carolina with 72 daily departures provided by Air Tran, American, Delta, Southwest, United, US Airways and their regional airline partners. According to the FAA, ORF is ranked as the 67<sup>th</sup> largest primary airport in the United States with nearly 3.3 million scheduled passengers served in 2012.*
