Norfolk International Airport reports on October 2013 activity

NORFOLK, Va. – (November 14, 2013) – Norfolk International Airport (ORF) reported a 3.98 percent decrease in passenger activity for the month of October 2013 with 255,004 passengers. This figure compares to an October 2012 passenger count of 265,585. For the January - October 2013 period, passenger activity has decreased 5.86 percent versus the corresponding period in 2012.

In other activity, 4,779,184 pounds of cargo were shipped in and out of the airport during October 2013. This represents a 14.35 percent decrease versus October 2012, which saw 5,579,970 pounds of cargo shipped. For the January - October 2013 period, cargo activity has decreased 16.67 percent versus the corresponding period in 2012.

The above-mentioned figures are a reflection of the service by the following airlines: American, Delta, Southwest, United, US Airways and their regional airline partners. Cargo carriers include Federal Express, Mountain Air Cargo and UPS.

Norfolk International Airport (ORF) is the major airport serving Coastal Virginia and Northeast North Carolina with 75 daily departures provided by American, Delta, Southwest, United, US Airways and their regional airline partners. According to the FAA, ORF is ranked as the 67th largest primary airport in the United States with nearly 3.3 million scheduled passengers served in 2012.
