Norfolk International Airport reports on October 2015 activity

NORFOLK, Va. – (November 12, 2015) – Norfolk International Airport (ORF) reported a **10.26 percent increase** in passenger activity for the month of October 2015 with 270,121 passengers. This figure compares to an October 2014 passenger count of 244,988. For the January - October 2015 period, passenger activity has increased 1.17 percent versus the corresponding period in 2014.

In other activity, 5,337,625 pounds of cargo were shipped in and out of the airport during October 2015. This represents a **5.67 percent increase** versus October 2014, which saw 5,051,050 pounds of cargo shipped. For the January - October 2015 period, cargo activity has increased 6.12 percent versus the corresponding period in 2014.

The above-mentioned figures are a reflection of the service by the following airlines: American, Delta, Southwest, United, US Airways and their regional airline partners. Cargo carriers include Federal Express, Mountain Air Cargo and UPS.

Norfolk International Airport (ORF) is the major airport serving Southeast Virginia and Northeast North Carolina with 68 daily departures provided by American, Delta, Southwest, United, US Airways and their regional airline partners. Together they provide nonstop access to 16 major airports including international gateways, allowing convenient access to global destinations. According to the FAA, ORF is ranked as the 70th largest primary airport in the United States (2014) with approximately 3 million scheduled passengers served.
