Norfolk International Airport reports on September 2014 activity

NORFOLK, Va. – (October 22, 2014) – Norfolk International Airport (ORF) reported a 6.66 percent decrease in passenger activity for the month of September 2014 with 234,769 passengers. This figure compares to a September 2013 passenger count of 251,529. For the January - September 2014 period, passenger activity has decreased 3.81 percent versus the corresponding period in 2013.

In other activity, 4,569,258 pounds of cargo were shipped in and out of the airport during September 2014. This represents a 0.08 percent increase versus September 2013, which saw 4,565,564 pounds of cargo shipped. For the January - September 2014 period, cargo activity has decreased 6.94 percent versus the corresponding period in 2013.

The above-mentioned figures are a reflection of the service by the following airlines: AirTran, American, Delta, Southwest, United, US Airways and their regional airline partners. Cargo carriers include Federal Express, Mountain Air Cargo and UPS.

Norfolk International Airport (ORF) is the major airport serving Southeast Virginia and Northeast North Carolina with 68 daily departures provided by American, Delta, Southwest, United, US Airways and their regional airline partners. According to the FAA, ORF is ranked as the 67th largest primary airport in the United States (2012) with over 3.1 million scheduled passengers served in 2013.
