## Norfolk International Airport Reports on May 2023 Activity

**NORFOLK**, **Va. - (June 15, 2023)** – Norfolk International Airport (ORF) reported a 3.3 percent increase in passenger activity for the month of May 2023 with 405,894 passengers, representing the busiest May and the second busiest month overall in the history of the airport. This figure compares to a May 2022 passenger count of 392,942. January to May 2023 total passenger count has increased 9.1 percent representing 1,651,734 passengers compared to 1,514,349 passengers during the same period in 2022.

In other activity, 5,026,076 pounds of cargo were shipped in and out of the airport during May 2023. This represents a 3.1 percent decrease compared to May 2022, which saw 5,184,466 pounds of cargo shipped. January to May 2023 cargo pounds shipped has decreased 2.3% percent representing 24,946,757 cargo pounds compared to 25,539,765 cargo pounds during the same period in 2022.

The above-mentioned figures reflect service by scheduled airlines Allegiant, American, Breeze, Delta, Frontier, Southwest, Spirit, United and their regional airline partners, as well as charter airlines. All-cargo carriers include Federal Express and UPS.

Norfolk International Airport is the major airport serving coastal Virginia and northeast North Carolina, ranking in the top 14% of U.S. airports with over 4.1 million passengers and over 75,000 flight operations in 2022. Skytrax has awarded Norfolk Airport a 4-Star Regional Airport rating. Among 572 airports rated in the 2023 survey, Norfolk Airport is one of just seven 4-Star airports in the U.S. Skytrax annual ratings are known as a global benchmark of airport standards.
