Norfolk International Airport Reports on June 2023 Activity

NORFOLK, Va. - (July 13, 2023) – Norfolk International Airport (ORF) reported a 7.5 percent increase in passenger activity for the month of June 2023 with 431,637 passengers, marking the greatest number of passengers for the month of June in the airport's history. This figure compares to a June 2022 passenger count of 401,517. January to June 2023 total passenger count has increased 8.7 percent representing 2,083,371 passengers compared to 1,915,866 passengers during the same period in 2022.

In other activity, 5,241,337 pounds of cargo were shipped in and out of the airport during June 2023. This represents a 5.7 percent decrease compared to June 2022, which saw 5,560,882 pounds of cargo shipped. January to June 2023 cargo pounds shipped has decreased 2.9% percent representing 30,188,094 cargo pounds compared to 31,100,647 cargo pounds during the same period in 2022.

The above-mentioned figures reflect service by scheduled airlines Allegiant, American, Breeze, Delta, Frontier, Southwest, Spirit, United and their regional airline partners, as well as charter airlines. All-cargo carriers include Federal Express and UPS.

Norfolk International Airport is the major airport serving coastal Virginia and northeast North Carolina, ranking in the top 14% of U.S. airports with over 4.1 million passengers and over 75,000 flight operations in 2022. Skytrax has awarded Norfolk Airport a 4-Star Regional Airport rating. Among 572 airports rated in the 2023 survey, Norfolk Airport is one of just seven 4-Star airports in the U.S. Skytrax annual ratings are known as a global benchmark of airport standards.
