## Norfolk International Airport Reports on September 2023 Activity

**NORFOLK, Va. - (October 17, 2023)** – Norfolk International Airport (ORF) reported a 10.6 percent increase in passenger activity for the month of September 2023 with 385,988 passengers, marking the eighth consecutive record-setting month. This figure compares to a September 2022 passenger count of 349,082. January to September 2023 total passenger count has increased 9.2 percent representing 3,385,235 passengers compared to 3,100,375 passengers during the same period in 2022.

In other activity, 4,398,733 pounds of cargo were shipped in and out of the airport during September 2023. This represents an 18.1 percent decrease compared to September 2022, which saw 5,371,250 pounds of cargo shipped. January to September 2023 cargo pounds shipped has decreased 5.8% percent representing 44,409,907 cargo pounds compared to 47,167,837 cargo pounds during the same period in 2022.

The above-mentioned figures reflect service by scheduled airlines Allegiant, American, Breeze, Delta, Frontier, Southwest, Spirit, United and their regional airline partners, as well as charter airlines. All-cargo carriers include Federal Express and UPS.

Norfolk International Airport is the major airport serving coastal Virginia and northeast North Carolina, ranking in the top 14% of U.S. airports with over 4.1 million passengers and over 75,000 flight operations in 2022. Skytrax has awarded Norfolk Airport a 4-Star Regional Airport rating. Among 572 airports rated in the 2023 survey, Norfolk Airport is one of just seven 4-Star airports in the U.S. Skytrax annual ratings are known as a global benchmark of airport standards.
