New application for \$29,500,000 for 3 projects
 08-001 Long Term East Conversion to RON Parking
 08-002 Pedestrian Bridge People Movers
 08-003 Alpha Concourse Gate Addition

All projects to be funded by PFCS on a pay-as-you-go basis

08-001 – Long Term East Conversion to RON Parking

Description:

- Conversion of 35,000 square yards of existing long term vehicle parking into five remain over night aircraft parking (RON) positions
- RON positions are accessed from the south side of Concourse B via existing pavement

Objective:

This project enhances capacity at ORF by adding additional RON positions at ORF

Justification:

- Due to enplaned passenger growth at ORF over the last few years, the Authority is experiencing aircraft parking capacity issues at its gates on a nightly basis
- Conversion of long term east vehicle parking to RON positions will help alleviate that issues



08-001 – Long Term East Conversion to RON Parking



08-002 – Pedestrian Bridge People Movers

Description:

- Pedestrian Bridge is an existing 354' long enclosed structure that serves as point-to-point access between the Arrivals and Departures Terminal Buildings at ORF
- Currently there is no moving walkway on the bridge to assist passengers with the walking distance
- Project will install 2 moving walkways in the Pedestrian Bridge

Objective:

• Project will make it easier for passengers, including passengers requiring accommodations under the Americans with Disabilities Act, to transit between the Arrival and Departure Terminals

Justification:

- Pedestrian Bridge is the primary circulation path between the long term parking garages and the departure gates and from the departure gates to baggage claim
- Walking distance between the furthest airline gate and bag claim is 2,200 feet or 0.41 miles
 Some passengers, including elderly and those with disabilities, have difficulty with the walking distance
- Moving walkways will provide these passengers with a chance to rest while still moving through the terminal complex

08-002 – Pedestrian Bridge People Movers



08-003 – Alpha Concourse Gate Addition

Description:

- Design and construction of additional holdroom space and and restrooms at the end of the existing Alpha Concourse
- Total expansion will be approximately 13,000 square feet with three holdrooms at 2,500 square feet each
- Includes 4 new passenger loading bridges intended to mitigate the need for ground loading operations currently occurring at the end of the Alpha Concourse
- Expansion is 100% eligible for PFCs

Objective:

This project enhances the capacity of ORF by adding 3 gates and 4 loading bridges intended to accommodate current operational needs

Justification:

- Due to enplaned passenger growth over the past few years at ORF, the Authority is experiencing aircraft parking capacity issues at the gates
- Project will convert an area used for ground loading aircraft to holdroom space for 3 gates

Total Project Cost: \$33,000,000 PFC Share: \$23,000,000



Summary of PFC Application

- PFC Level: \$4.50 per eligible enplaned passenger
- PFC Revenue to be Collected: \$29,500,000
- Charge Effective Date: Proposed application will become effective upon the expiration of PFC # 22-07-C-00 which is currently estimated to be fully collected by December 2025
- Charge Expiration Date: November 1, 2028
