## Norfolk International Airport Reports on February 2024 Activity

**NORFOLK, Va. - (March 13, 2024)** – Norfolk International Airport (ORF) reported a 13.2 percent increase in passenger activity for the month of February 2024 with 298,452 passengers. This figure compares to a February 2023 passenger count of 263,669. February 2024 was the 13<sup>th</sup> consecutive month of record-setting passenger activity. January to February 2024 total passenger count has increased 11.9 percent representing 601,905 passengers compared to 538,112 passengers during the same period in 2023.

In other activity, 3,809,837 pounds of cargo were shipped in and out of the airport during February 2024. This represents a 19.8 percent decrease compared to February 2023, which saw 4,751,089 pounds of cargo shipped. January to February 2024 cargo pounds shipped has decreased 26.1 percent representing 7,103,034 cargo pounds versus 9,614,193 cargo pounds during the same period in 2023.

The above-mentioned figures reflect service by scheduled airlines Allegiant, American, Breeze, Delta, Frontier, Southwest, Spirit, United and their airline partners, as well as charter airlines. All-cargo carriers include Federal Express and UPS.

Norfolk International Airport is the major airport serving coastal Virginia and northeast North Carolina, ranking in the top 13% of U.S. airports with over 4.5 million passengers and over 75,000 flight operations in 2023. Skytrax has awarded Norfolk Airport a <u>4-Star Regional Airport</u> rating. Among 572 airports rated in the 2023 survey, Norfolk Airport is one of just seven 4-Star airports in the U.S. Skytrax annual ratings are known as a global benchmark of airport standards.
