## Norfolk International Airport Reports on January 2024 Activity

**NORFOLK, Va. - (February 14, 2024)** – Norfolk International Airport (ORF) reported a 10.6 percent increase in passenger activity for the month of January 2024 with 303,453 passengers. This figure compares to a January 2023 passenger count of 274,443. January 2024 was the 12<sup>th</sup> straight month of record-setting passenger activity.

In other activity, 3,293,197 pounds of cargo were shipped in and out of the airport during January 2024. This represents a 32.3 percent decrease compared to January 2023, which saw 4,863,104 pounds of cargo shipped.

The above-mentioned figures reflect service by scheduled airlines Allegiant, American, Breeze, Delta, Frontier, Southwest, Spirit, United and their airline partners, as well as charter airlines. All-cargo carriers include Federal Express and UPS.

Norfolk International Airport is the major airport serving coastal Virginia and northeast North Carolina, ranking in the top 13% of U.S. airports with over 4.5 million passengers and over 75,000 flight operations in 2023. Skytrax has awarded Norfolk Airport a <u>4-Star Regional Airport</u> rating. Among 572 airports rated in the 2023 survey, Norfolk Airport is one of just seven 4-Star airports in the U.S. Skytrax annual ratings are known as a global benchmark of airport standards.
