Norfolk International Airport Reports on March 2024 Activity

NORFOLK, Va. - (April 11, 2024) – Norfolk International Airport (ORF) reported a 12.5 percent increase in passenger activity for March 2024 with 375,062 passengers. This figure compares to a March 2023 passenger count of 333,484. Last month was the busiest March in the airport's history and was the 14th consecutive month of record-setting passenger activity. January to March 2024 total passenger count increased 12 percent representing 976,967 passengers compared to 872,106 passengers during the same period in 2023.

In other activity, 4,108,336 pounds of cargo were shipped in and out of the airport during March 2024, a 25.8 percent decrease compared the 5,539,346 pounds of cargo shipped in March 2023. January to March 2024 cargo pounds shipped decreased 26 percent representing 11,211,370 cargo pounds versus 15,153,539 cargo pounds during last year's first quarter.

The above-mentioned figures reflect service by scheduled airlines Allegiant, American, Breeze, Delta, Frontier, Southwest, Spirit, United and their airline partners, as well as charter airlines. All-cargo carriers include Federal Express and UPS.

Norfolk International Airport is the major airport serving coastal Virginia and northeast North Carolina, ranking in the top 13% of U.S. airports with over 4.5 million passengers and over 75,000 flight operations in 2023. Skytrax has awarded Norfolk Airport a <u>4-Star Regional Airport</u> rating. Among 572 airports rated in the 2023 survey, Norfolk Airport is one of just seven 4-Star airports in the U.S. Skytrax annual ratings are known as a global benchmark of airport standards.
